FUNdraising Flyer Distribution -

March 17th / 18th

We Need Flyers!!

Please speak with the local businesses that you go to. Ask them if we can help with their advertising!

Flyer pick up is March 14th. Flyer collation will be on March 15th and distribution will be on the weekend of March 17th / 18th !

This is a great help in allowing the scouts program to function without the hindrance of event cost.

Look through the newspaper and coupon booklets that come in the mail. These are the businesses that use advertisement as a source of business. Call them or visit them, explain you are with the Boys Scouts and tell them that as a fundraiser we can distribute their flyer (that they provide to us) to the doorsteps of 3000 homes in the local Simi Valley area for ONLY \$100 which can be written off as either a donation or advertising expense.

If all families bring in flyers this can be a very profitable fundraiser.

Your families' help will also be appreciated on Thursday March 15th for collating the flyers. The more hands the easier the task. Plus we will need drivers for the weekend of March 17th / 18th .

Monies collected through this fundraiser will be divided into 3 phases:

Phase 1 = Scouts who bring in Flyers gets 1/3 of the \$100 for each flyer

Phase 2 = 1/3 of total split between the boys who

helped collate

Phase 3 = 1/3 of total split between the boys who helped distribute
